Agencies/ institutions



## ENFORCEMENT OF THE MTDP



## Local Governance Act, 2016 (Act 936)

 Mandates District Assemblies to approve, own and implement development plans, programs and projects in the district.

 Gives authority to District Assembly not to approve any development project or program which is inconsistent with or not in conformity with the approved development plan of the District.

## CHARACTERISTICS OF THE PLAN



plan should be inspired by, and consistent with national development agendas

Proposed interventions should meet the needs of a diverse society

Promote continuity of ongoing projects, maintenance arrangements for existing projects/infrastructure

simple, clear, easy understanding - Visual representation (Maps/charts)

generally accepted by key stakeholders





## PRIORITIZIATION PROCESS




- Prioritization done using Pairwise Ranking Method
